# Re-cycled copper

Copper is 100% recyclable, so it is possible that the pans contain some copper that was first used many centuries ago, perhaps during the Roman Empire.

The winner covered the 30km in just over 33 mins, an average speed of 54.4kph, or 33.8mph for 18.6 miles, although all of the riders will have been spurred on by the copper cacophony.
