Copper is a natural material, tubes are 100% copper – no additives or chemicals. You know exactly what you are getting with copper.

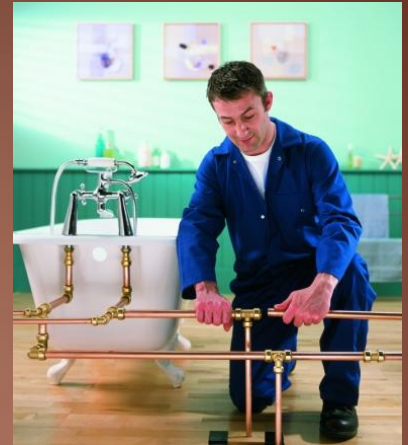


7. Chic, good looking
